

## Scholarships



***Madicken Munk — 2009 Scholarship Winner***

The U.S. Department of Energy Office of Nuclear Energy (DOE-NE) awarded 85 scholarships to U.S. undergraduate students in FY 2010 through its Nuclear Energy University Programs (NEUP) initiative.

The program's objective is to attract high-quality undergraduate students into Nuclear Science and Engineering (NS&E) disciplines and to help train and educate the next generation of nuclear scientists and engineers.

Scholarship recipients received \$5,000 toward the cost of his or her education for the 2010–2011 academic year. They are eligible to apply for the scholarship in subsequent years.

### ***Scholarship Requirements***

For a student to be considered for a scholarship, he or she must be:

- A U.S. citizen
- At least a freshman when applying
- Enrolled in a NEUP-accepted college or university
- Earning a bachelor's degree in a nuclear-energy related discipline such as materials or mechanical engineering, radiochemistry and health physics.

### ***Application Requirements***

Scholarship applications are reviewed by a selection committee. Each applicant is required to provide:

- College transcripts
- A personal statement describing their career goals
- Two letters of reference
- ACT/SAT scores

### ***Scholarships — Review***

To evaluate the intellectual merit criterion, panels consider:


- The strength of the academic record
- References
- ACT or SAT scores
- The appropriateness of the choice of institution relative to the proposed plan for education
